BAPS has announced the completion of the Swaminarayan Akshardham temple in Robbinsville, New Jersey



Largest Hindu temple in the United States



Constructed from 2011-2023



185 acres

Akshardham includes design elements from ancient Indian art, architecture, and culture including

10,000

statues, carvings of ancient Indian musical instruments and dance forms, and water from the holy rivers of India.

to build the temple.

Largest Elliptical Dome

ever constructed from stone.

THE UNIQUE TEMPLE DESIGN INCLUDES:

9 shikhars (spire-like structures)

9 Pyramidal shikhars

12 sub-shrines
