#### THE TASTING TRAIL

Discover the state's 50+ wineries by following one of New Jersey's five wine trails. Covering the most distance and wineries, the Vintage North Jersey Grand Wine Trail features 10 stops, including third-generation Ventimiglia Vineyards, award-winning Four Sisters Winery and the artisanal Unionville Vineyards. #### MOUNTAIN MAGIC

Find four peaks, the region's highest vertical and the only true All-Mountain Terrain Park south of Vermont at Mountain Creek. Beyond ski season, fly through trees and over mountain lakes at Zoom Ziplines, swoop down the Alpine Mountain Coaster or traverse 40+ miles of trails at Mountain Creek Bike Park, which features the longest lift-served riding season in North America. #### TO A TEE

Discover seven award-winning golf courses within a five-mile radius at Crystal Springs Resort, the third-largest golf resort in the world. Layouts include Ballyowen, rated #1 in New Jersey. ## TRAILS AND TREASURES ITINERARY ADD-ONS

If you have two or more days in New Jersey, these suggestions will enhance your visit:

### + | SLEEPING UNDER THE STARS

New Jersey offers plenty of scenic campgrounds, from the Delaware Water Gap National Recreation Area in the northwest to the Pine Barrens in the south. Camp Taylor features access to the Appalachian Trail, as well as the haunting sound of wolves howling in the night. No worries: it's just the pack at the Lakota Wolf Preserve, the Northeast's largest wolf preserve. ### + | UNDERGROUND MYSTERIES

The main attraction on the 1,300-foot underground stroll of the historic Sterling Hill zinc mine is passing through the "glow in the dark" Rainbow Tunnel, where fluorescent zinc creates an otherworldly experience. ### + | ON A CLEAR DAY

You can see three states! At High Point State Park, climb to the top of High Point Monument, an obelisk memorial to NJ war veterans and the state's highest elevation. In addition to enjoying breathtaking views, go horseback riding, birding, canoeing or hiking on the Appalachian Trail. ### + | IT TAKES A LAKE

With 45 miles of shoreline, Lake Hopatcong, New Jersey's largest freshwater lake, is an ideal destination for windsurfing, water skiing, fishing and boating of all kinds—whether your "ship" is a canoe, pontoon boat, sailboat or speedboat. ### + | SOUTHERN EXPOSURE

For more rugged and refined experiences, head south! Outdoor enthusiasts will find cabins, campsites and even yurts throughout South Jersey's famous Pine Barrens as well as hiking, birding, wildlife and equestrian trails. Epicureans can trek the Pinelands Reserve Wine Trail, which includes Tomasello Winery, the state's oldest continuously owned family winery.
